**Application Procedure**

To be considered for a College of Engineering Scholarship, applicants must submit:

- This completed application form.
- Official transcript from WSU and/or other school attending.
- Your parents previous year's 1040 tax form (or yours if you file independently).
- A cover letter explaining why you believe you qualify for a scholarship. (Cover letter should include a personal statement concerning your academic and career goals extracurricular activities and other information you deem important to this award process).
- A letter of recommendation is not required, but may be included.
- If you are currently enrolled at Wayne State and are granted a scholarship, it is **Mandatory** that you attend the **College of Engineering Honors Convocation Ceremony, tentatively scheduled for April 1, 2005**, to accept your scholarship award.

**Note:** You are not eligible for an Engineering Scholarship if you will be a Merit Scholar, a Presidential Scholar, or if you will be receiving another form of full tuition assistance for the time period for which you are applying for the Engineering Scholarship. Engineering Scholarships, in combination with other partial scholarships or financial aid, will not be awarded in amounts exceeding your total tuition. We will contact the WSU Financial Aid Office to verify financial need for students wishing to be considered for scholarships that include this as a criterion. **To document financial need, you must submit a FAFSA form to the University by February 15, 2005.**

You **must** complete **all** parts of this application. Information requested in this application will be used to determine your eligibility for the various scholarships offered by the College of Engineering. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of a variety of factors, including: academic performance, financial need, field of engineering, co-op participation, extracurricular activities, full or part time status.
