Please read these instructions before completing the application for Guest admission

1. The purpose of Guest admission is to serve two types of students:
 - a. The student interested in taking courses at Wayne State for one (1) semester and who then returns to his/her current institution.
 - b. The student attending another accredited institution who wishes to register **concurrently** for courses at Wayne State.
2. Below are the requirements for admission as a WSU Guest student.
 - a. Completed a minimum of 15 semester hours at your current institution.
 - b. Be in attendance within the academic year at an accredited institution, in good standing and be eligible to return.
 - c. Have earned a minimum cumulative "C" average (H.P.A. = 2.0) or better and not be on academic probation.

To verify that you meet the admission requirements to be a WSU Guest student, the Registrar's Office at your current institution must complete the shaded box at the top of this page.
3. **Guest Admission is for the semester in which it is issued. You may register for one additional, consecutive semester by completing another guest application (front side only). Your college or university does not need to complete the top portion of this page. If you would like to be a guest student any semester thereafter you would need to complete both sides of the Guest Application and submit another application fee.** You are permitted to be a Guest student in two consecutive semester intervals.
4. You may register for classes in which you have completed appropriate prerequisites. Courses within certain professional programs at WSU may not be open to guest students. It is the discretion of the Office of University Admissions and the academic departments to determine whether or not Guest students are permitted to take courses within certain professional programs.
5. A \$20.00 (\$30.00 for international students) non-refundable application fee, check or money order, made payable to "Wayne State University" must be returned with this application. Checks drawn on Canadian or other foreign banks should carry the notation, "Payable in U.S. Funds, plus service charges."
6. If you intend to transfer credits completed as a WSU Guest student to your current institution, it is recommended that you check with your college advisor as to whether the credits are transferrable. To have your WSU transcript sent to your home institution, contact the WSU Records Office at (313) 577-3531.
